Classic Vinyl Fence Warranty & Maintenance Manual

Limited Lifetime Vinyl Fence Warranty

Classic Vinyl Fence warrants that its vinyl fencing products, when purchased, installed, and used under normal conditions and in accordance with approved engineering design criteria, are free from defects in material and workmanship.

Under normal use, Classic Vinyl fencing products will not peel, pit, rot, blister, warp, suffer abnormal weathering, or be consumed by insects. Should a covered defect or material degradation be discovered, Classic Vinyl Fence will, at its sole discretion, repair or replace the defective material. This warranty includes reasonable labor charges required to correct the covered defect.

This warranty is subject to all standard terms, conditions, and limitations of purchase.

All Classic Vinyl Fencing systems are manufactured with **TriGard® Protection**, engineered specifically for harsh outdoor environments. TriGard is formulated to combat the damaging effects of UV rays, temperature fluctuations, cracking, and thermal expansion.

This advanced protection helps preserve the structural integrity and color consistency of your vinyl fence, maintaining its appearance while extending its overall lifespan.

Dirt Buildup & Environmental Exposure

Vinyl fencing is extremely durable; however, no exterior product is completely immune to environmental exposure. Climate conditions, airborne pollutants, landscaping debris, and everyday outdoor elements can contribute to dirt buildup over time.

Preventing the accumulation of dirt and organic material in fence crevices, joints, and gate components is important for maintaining appearance and performance. Routine cleaning also helps discourage insects and bacteria while preserving the fence's finish.

Cleaning Guidelines for Classic Vinyl Fencing & Gates

To protect the vinyl surface and maintain its finish, clean your fence as needed using gentle methods:

- Gently wipe the surface with a wet sponge or soft cloth to remove loose dirt and debris. A soft-bristle brush may be used for textured areas or crevices.
- For salt residue, pollen, or more stubborn deposits, use a mild detergent mixed with water and apply with a soft brush.
- Use only non-abrasive detergents that are free of solvents or petroleum-based chemicals, as these may damage the vinyl surface.
- A helpful guideline: if a cleaning product is not safe to touch with bare skin, it should not be used on your fence or gates.
- Rinse thoroughly with lukewarm water to remove all soap residue.
- Allow the fence to air dry naturally or wipe dry with a clean, soft cloth for a streak-free finish.

Do not use abrasive pads, harsh chemicals, solvent-based cleaners, or pressure washers at close range, as these may damage the vinyl surface and could void warranty coverage.

Ongoing Fence & Gate Maintenance

Maintenance frequency will vary depending on climate and environmental conditions. Coastal areas, high-traffic locations, and regions with heavy pollen or pollution may require more frequent cleaning.

General maintenance recommendations include:

- Periodically inspect fence panels, posts, and gates for dirt buildup or debris.
- Clean vinyl fencing at least once per year to prevent long-term buildup and preserve appearance.
- Promptly rinse off salt, mud, fertilizer, or landscaping chemicals that come into contact with the fence.
- Ensure gate hardware and moving components remain clean and unobstructed.

With minimal routine care, your Classic Vinyl Fence will continue to provide long-lasting durability, structural performance, and curb appeal for many years.
